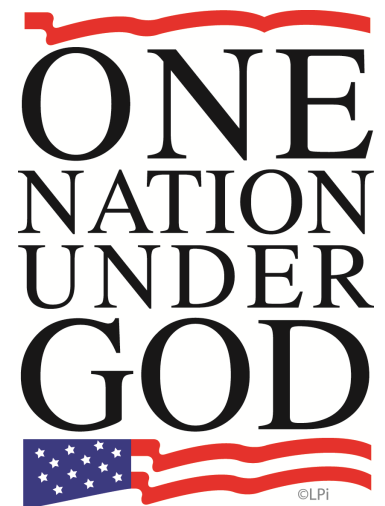

## *The Word In Our Lives* *Gospel Reflection*

### **Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time** **“Father and Son”**

Usually, we talk about the second part of the gospel. It's very comforting, promising rest to those who labor and a light burden for those who take Jesus' yoke, that is, are willing to be led by Jesus. But let's look at the first half of the passage. It almost sounds like a riddle with mysterious phrases. So what is Jesus saying?

First he talks about the Father hiding things “from the wise and the learned.” Some people think they know everything. They look down at people who have faith in Jesus as if they were simpletons. They usually say that faith is a way of hiding from reality; that only scientifically proven things are real. While people who think this way may be kind and generous, they are missing the deeper meaning of life. Jesus says that those hidden meanings are revealed to the “little ones,” those with a child-like ability to believe without proof, just because God tells them. These are the ones he talks about in the Beatitudes: “Blessed are the poor in spirit.. ..blessed are the meek.” (Mt 5:3, 5)

If you want the kind of faith Jesus is talking about, you have to be open to it. You have to be willing to see the world through the eyes of faith. Do you expect to see Jesus in the people you will talk to today? Do you listen to the scripture readings for how they can apply to you? Are you willing to accept the frustrations of life, or the mistakes you make, as opportunities to experience God's love and/or forgiveness?

The second saying is about knowing the Father through the Son. We could know little or nothing about God by ourselves. But the love God has for us can only be known if he reveals it. The Father and Son are one God; they never act separately or hide anything from each other. But we may be hiding from God. If we have sinned and are afraid to confess it to God, we are missing a chance to experience God's love when he forgives us. Remember, Jesus did the hard part by dying for our sins.

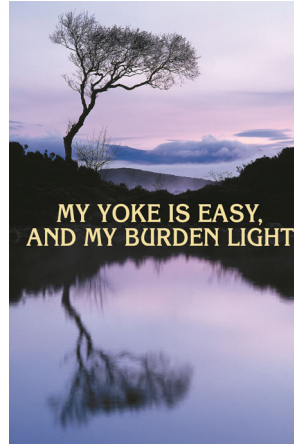

## *Ask A Priest, Deacon, or DRE*

**Is it a sin for a man to have long hair? In 1 Corinthians 11:14, St. Paul tells us long hair is degrading to and unnatural for a man. All the pictures of Jesus show him with long hair.**

The pictures we have of Christ are not from any physical description we have of him in the Bible, because there is none. The basic image comes from tradition. In Biblical times, the Jewish men would wear their hair down to their shoulders, while Jewish women would have their hair down to their waists. St. Paul was telling the Corinthian men that wearing hair down to the waist as women did would be wrong because it would be 'dressing like a woman.'
