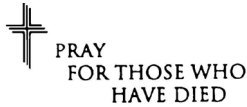

Since 1956, the **LATIN AMERICAN APOSTOLATE** of St. Louis has provided Priests from the Archdiocese of St. Louis to serve in LaPaz, Bolivia. One of our priests, Morgan Casey, is a Bishop in Bolivia and Father Hayden and Father Michler are staffing a large parish in LaPaz. Our Missionaries preach the Gospel, form catechists, celebrate the Sacraments, and help form the people as missionary disciples of the Lord. A health clinic in Maria Reina parish in LaPaz helps meet the needs of the poor who seek medical care and food.
