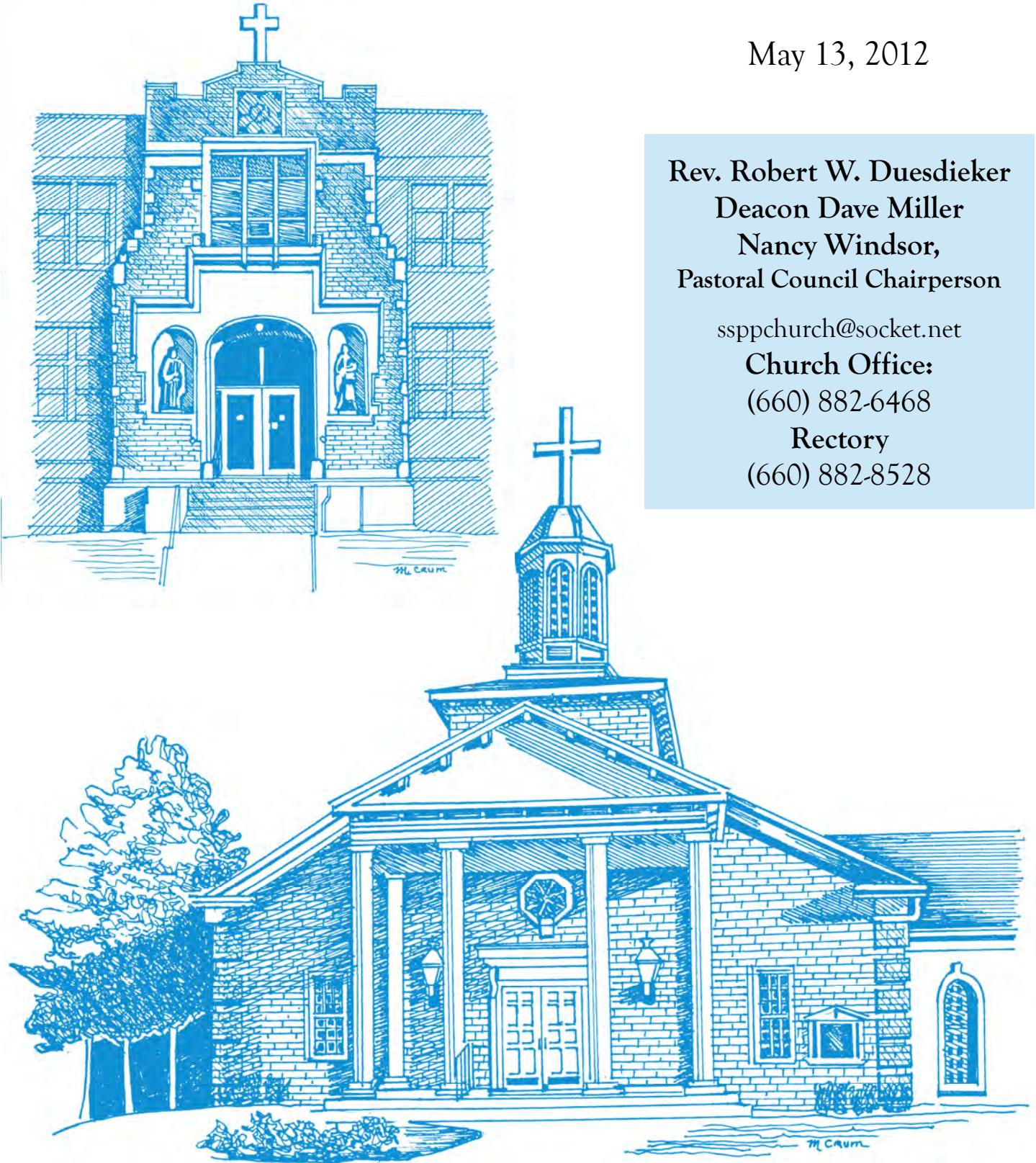

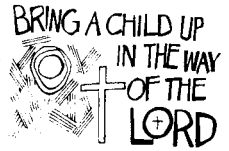

Total pledges since the start of the Capital Campaign are \$2,697,525 with \$2,346,760 or 87.0 percent received in cash. \$350,765 remains to be collected. 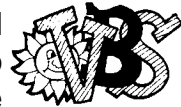
