From the desk of the Pastor . . .

So why do priests oversee maintenance in the first place?

One thing they didn't teach in the seminary was Church Repair Class. However, roofs, boilers, air-conditioners and appliances have taken up a lot of my time and been cause for much distress. Our faithful and capable maintenance man, Dave Herbig, continues to be a huge help, but Mrs. Kauffman and I give him so much work, *we never have time to develop a long term plan for the facility*. So I've been thinking about having a group of parishioners who knows more about these things than me to call on. The group will be called the **Facilities Committee**. If you have expertise in building maintenance, heating and cooling, electric, plumbing, windows, roofing, appliances, etc, I would like us to meet once in the spring and once the fall for a few hours to walk through and evaluate our plant and recommend actions items for the Finance and Parish Councils, Dave and myself, to act on. This translates into proactive budgeting and preventative maintenance. And in the event that I need consultation on a particular problem, I could call on the Facilities Committee or individuals from the committee for advice on projects that come up from time to time.
