We have been having trouble with the church furnaces (both of them). Wind keeps blowing out the pilot lights because of holes rusted in the fire chambers. This situation is very dangerous and a health hazard (carbon monoxide poison). In their current condition the units will not pass a safety inspection. I feel it is imperative they be replaced as soon as possible. With advice, I have decided to replace both heating units. They are nearly 46 years old I am told. The replacement cost is \$6,650.00 (\$3,325.00 per unit). I feel the price is good and we have enough money to cover the cost. Any questions, contact me.
