Normandy Area Voting Guide

Ballot Issues for April 8th, 2003

Introduction

In support of our community, the Msgr. Sprenke Council here in Normandy is providing this guide to help voters get prepared for the General Municipal Election coming up on Tuesday, April 8th.

Municipalities covered in this guide are those where a majority of our members reside – Village of Bellerive, Village of Bel-Nor, Village of Bel-Ridge, City of Greendale, City of Normandy, City of Pasadena Hills, and the Village of Pasadena Park.

The ballot items listed in this guide were researched using information supplied by the Board of Election Commissioners of St. Louis County, Missouri.

We have tried to ensure that the language in this guide matches the ballots that you will see on election day. The order of candidates shown in this guide should be the same order that will exist on the actual ballots. For your convenience, a copy of this guide will be placed on our council web site.

METROPOLITAN SEWER DISTRICT:

Special Bond Election

Proposition MSD (vote Yes or No, Simple Majority Required)

To comply with federal and state clean water requirements, shall the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD) issue its sewer system revenue bonds in the amount of Five Hundred Million Dollars (\$ 500, 000, 000) for the purpose of constructing, improving, renovating, repairing, replacing and equipping new and existing MSD sewer facilities and system, including sewer disposal and treatment plants, sanitary interceptor sewers and acquisition of easements and real property related thereto, the cost of operation and maintenance of said sewer system and the principal of and interest on said revenue bonds to be payable solely from the revenues derived by MSD from the operation of its sewer system, including all future extensions and improvements thereto?
